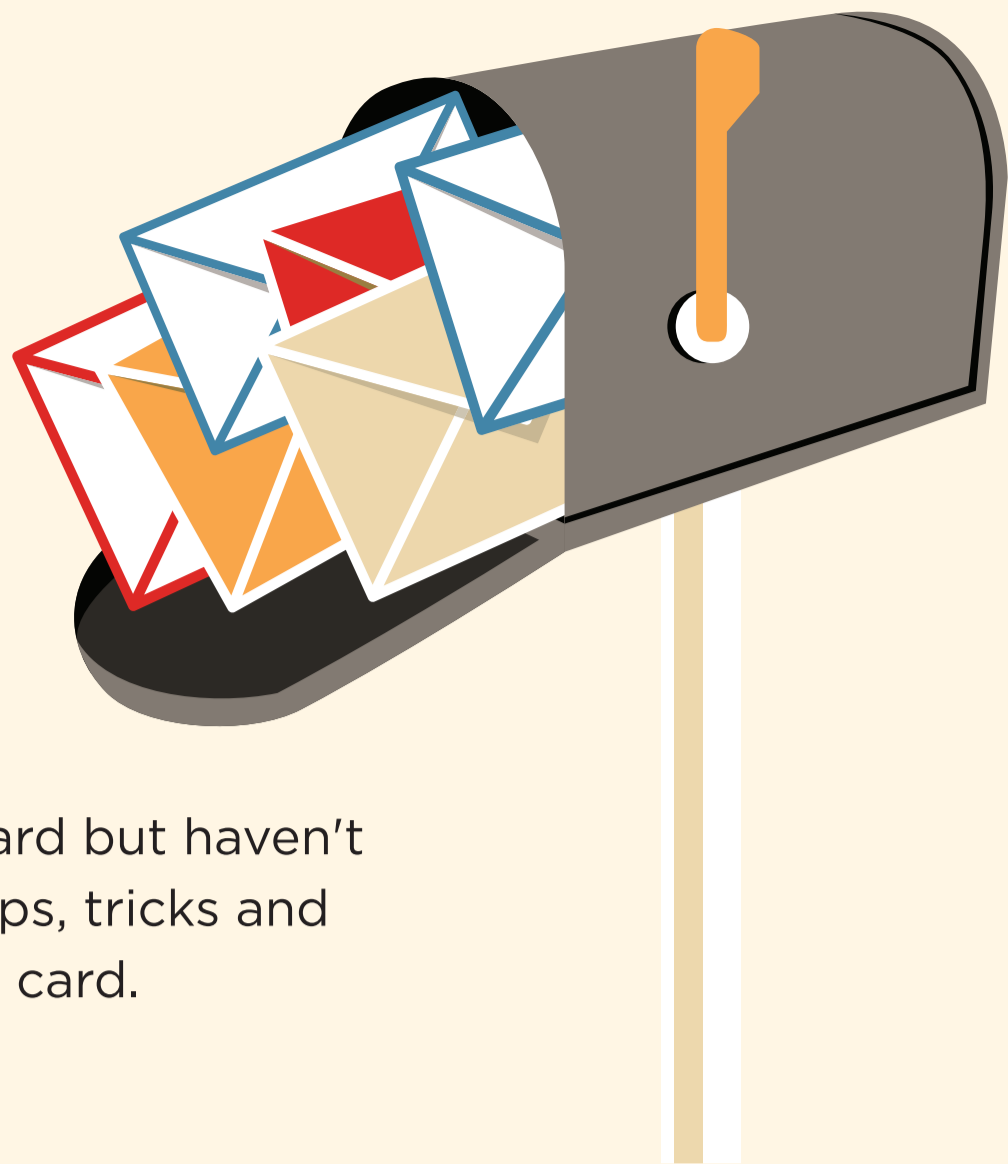


Sending HOLIDAY CARDS on a Time Crunch

Here are a few online services to help you design a stunning card. Some will even mail them out for you!



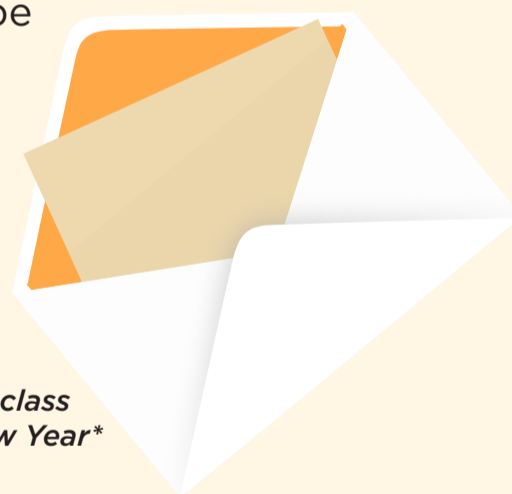
