

A craft project is a great way for kids to enjoy on a winter day, during winter break or to get into the holiday spirit. Here are some ideas that will be fun for you to do with the special kids in your life!



Homemade Snowman

Take two or three foam or plastic balls and glue them together. For the eyes, use crayons, markers or craft eyes. Create a smile, nose, hat and scarf from construction paper, and glue these onto the snowman.



Citrus Fruit Bird Feeders

Cut an assortment of oranges, lemons or grapefruits in half and take out all the fruit. Poke a few holes into the skins, scoop out the insides and tie some strong string or twine through them and knot. Fill the skins with a mix of three tablespoons of peanut butter, bird seed and a plain round cereal like regular Cheerios.



Craft Stick Ornaments

Decorate craft sticks with paint, crayons, markers and glitter. Glue the sticks together to create a star shape. Wrap twine or ribbon around the middle of the star, and glue a looped piece onto one of the sticks to hang.



Homemade Greeting Card

Fold a piece of colored paper in half.
Cut out shapes of snowmen, stars and other objects and glue onto the front of the card. These can then be further decorated with glitter, buttons or any art supplies you have on hand. Have the child write a greeting inside the card.
